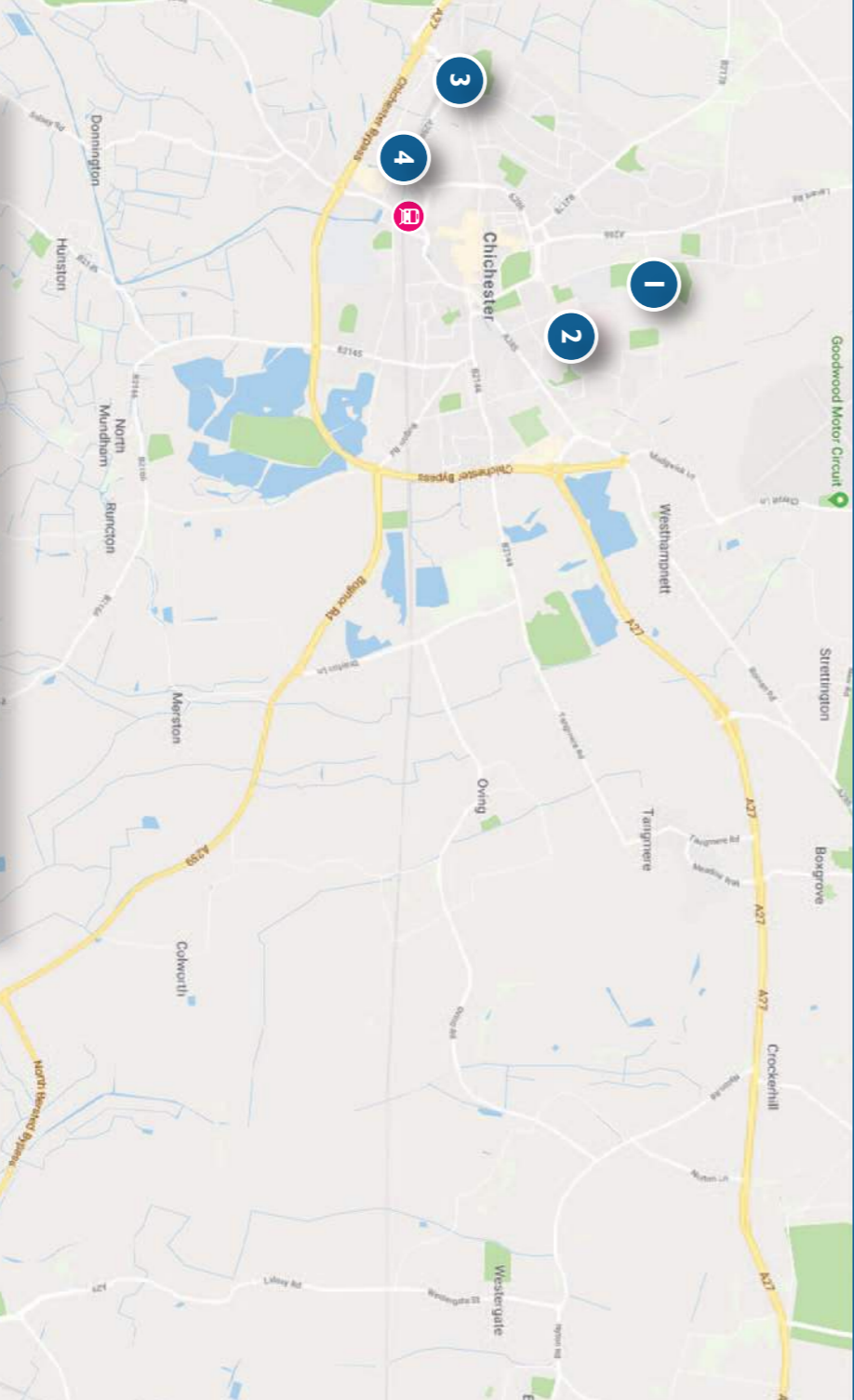

There is a great choice of university managed accommodation we are able to offer with different room types ranging from ensuite to shared facilities, catered to self-catered and studio apartments either as single or dual occupancy.

When you apply for accommodation you do not choose by property name. Instead you choose Chichester, Bognor Regis or university managed properties (off-campus) as the campus, ensuite or shared (standard/superior) facilities and catered or self-catered in a preference order. This is allocated using a randomised lottery-based system, not first-come, first-served. 1 Chichester campus PO19 6PE

Our Bishop Otter campus offers five different types of accommodation, ranging from ensuite, superior shared and shared facilities whilst offering catered or self-catered packages. Here you are located within the heart of the campus with all facilities just minutes away.

2 Chichester off-campus accommodation

- 19 Millfield Close, PO19 6UR (Ensuite/Self-Catered)
- 47 Spitalfield Lane, PO19 6SG (Ensuite/Self-Catered)
- 37 Lewis Road, PO19 7LZ (Shared Facilities/Self-Catered)

Our newest off-campus accommodation offers self-catered, ensuite or shared facilities. Each accommodation has six rooms.

3 Fishbourne Road East Halls PO19 3FH

Fishbourne Road East is a great option for our students who wish to branch out into the local community, whilst still being able to offer our 24-hour support and security. Located within a one minute walk of a Tesco Superstore and has direct, free bus links to both the Chichester and Bognor Regis campuses.

4 Stockbridge Halls PO19 8FG Sathav: PO19 8GP

Stockbridge Halls has over 400 rooms on an ensuite, self-catered basis. Located in the heart of Chichester city centre next to the Chichester Gate leisure complex consisting of Cineworld, Tenpin Bowling, numerous restaurants and a gym.

5 Prince Of Wales PO22 8BQ

Prince of Wales offers a high standard of off-campus accommodation located in the Bognor Regis area. Offering self-catered, ensuite packages and studio apartments either as single or dual occupancy. It is a five-minute walk from the Bognor Regis campus.

6 Bognor Regis campus PO21 1HR

Our Bognor Regis campus is home to two types of catered accommodation, offering both ensuite and shared facilities. Here you are located in the heart of the campus with all facilities just minutes away and only a nine-minute walk to Bognor's award winning beach.

7 Garth House PO21 1HQ

Our newest off-campus accommodation located in the Bognor Regis area. Offering self-catered, ensuite packages and studio apartments. It is a five-minute walk from the Bognor Regis campus.

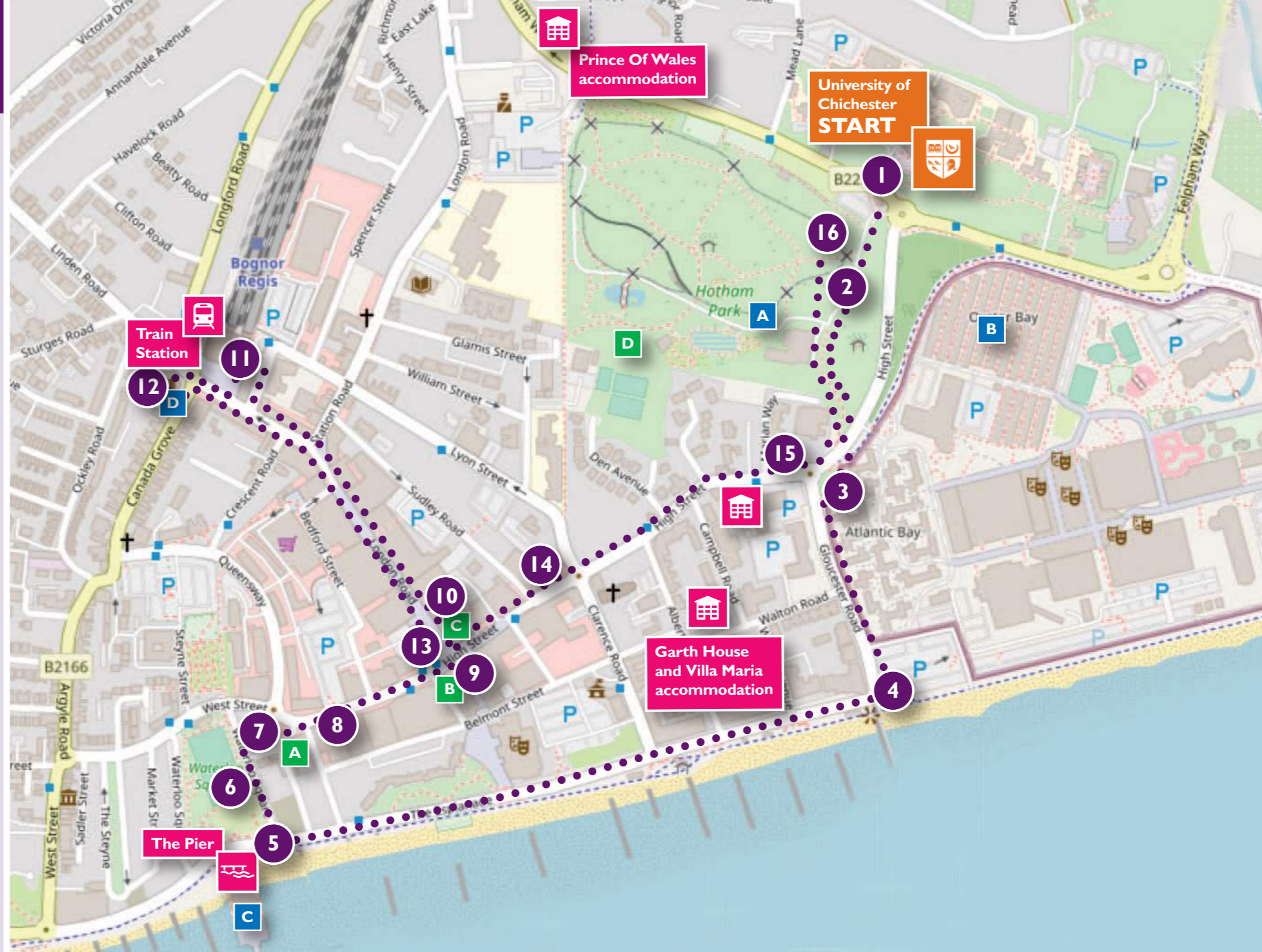
8 Villa Maria PO21 1NW

Villa Maria offers a high standard of off-campus accommodation located in Bognor Regis. Offering self-catered, ensuite packages and studio apartments either as single or dual occupancy. It is a 10-minute walk from the Bognor Regis campus.

Walking route



- 1 Head out of the campus exit next to St Michael's.
- 2 Cross the road and head through Hotham Park, while walking through the park follow the path to the left.
- 3 Cross over the road at the traffic lights and head down Gloucester Road.
- 4 When you reach the bottom of the road, you will reach the Bognor Regis promenade.
- 5 Walk along the promenade until you reach the Bognor Pier (Sheiks/Legends Bar).
- 6 Cross over the road to the Bognor Regis Crazy Golf and Mr P's Classic Amusements.
- 7 Walk along the road until you reach Pinks Parlour, then turn right and follow the road to left until you see Iceland supermarket.
- 8 When you've reached Iceland supermarket turn right and walk along the high street. You will see the Rocks Bar & Restaurant and T-Bone restaurant along the way.
- 9 After passing T-Bone, we have a few cafés and pubs such as Bonito Lounge, William Hardwicke.
- 10 On the left of Bonito Lounge is the main high street with several popular shops and cafes.
- 11 Walk along the main high street until you arrive at the train station on your right.
- 12 In front of you will be the Picturedrome cinema. They show the latest films for £3.50 on weekdays.
- 13 Head all the way down the high street until you reach Bonito Lounge.
- 14 Turn left walk along the path until you reach the small roundabout.
- 15 Cross straight over and carry on along the path until you reach Hotham Park.
- 16 Walk the way you went through Hotham Park earlier and you'll arrive at the entrance to the University of Chichester.

- A Hotham Park**
Hotham Park is Bognor's largest park, with a adventure golf course, boating lake, miniature railway and restaurant cafe on offer.
