


Nomination & application process

Nomination by 22 March 2026 Application by 26 April 2026

Spring Semester 2027 (sem 2), February start:

Nomination by 04 October 2026 Application by 01 November 2026

All nominations must be sent to **exchange@chi.ac.uk** with the following details: First name, surname, pronouns, nationality, email address, course name, course level, current year, exchange period

Students must complete at least one year at their home institution before studying at University of Chichester

We have two campuses, Bishop Otter campus and Bognor Regis campus, which are only 10 miles apart. There is a direct train link from Gatwick Airport to both Chichester and Bognor Regis, and we offer a free bus service for our students between the two campuses.

West Wittering beach & Bognor Regis beach are also easily accessible by bus.
