

2026/2027, September start:

Nomination by 22 March 2026  
Application by 26 April 2026

Spring Semester 2027 (sem 2), February start:

Nomination by 04 October 2026  
Application by 01 November 2026

Students must complete at least one year at their home institution before studying at University of Chichester

## *Our campus*

We have two campuses, Bishop Otter campus and Bognor Regis campus, which are only 10 miles apart. There is a direct train link from Gatwick Airport to both Chichester and Bognor Regis, and we offer a free bus service for our students between the two campuses.
