Application by 26 April 2027

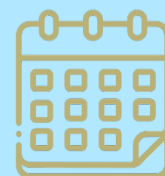
Spring Semester 2028 (sem 2), February start:

Our campus

We have two campuses, Bishop Otter campus and Bognor Regis campus, which are only 10 miles apart. There is a direct train link from Gatwick Airport to both Chichester and Bognor Regis, and we offer a free bus service for our students between the two campuses.

The typical UK semester structure is 4 modules (subjects) worth 15 UK credits each. Some degree programmes also have a structure of 3 modules per semester (worth 20 credits each).

We encourage all our Partners or interested exchange students to contact us directly, even before their nomination, to discuss modules and credits to ensure we can provide a suitable match. Due to accreditation constraints or specific structure, some degree programmes cannot accept exchange students: Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech and Language Therapy.
